- Attend required school events beyond the school day, such as Open House, curriculum night, and parent-teacher interviews
- Take advantage of professional development opportunities
- Communicate regularly with administration, parents and students regarding student progress
- Complete other duties as assigned by the school principal

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in relevant field or in education; Master's preferred
- Strong teaching background, including training and experience, in the relevant field
- Successful experience working with a diverse student population
- Quebec teaching license

Schedule and Accountability

- Approximately 30-80% of full-time, depending on student enrolment resulting sections needed
- Starting January 9, 2023
- Teaching and supervisory responsibilities fall mainly within the regular school day (8:00 am - 4:15 pm) Monday through Friday
- Reports to the principal
