

HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE POLICY - 2024-25

The **Kells** dress code is meant to allow students to be comfortable and to present themselves and represent their school in a positive way. It provides a simple, professional, and appropriate outfit that does not distract from the learning process.

The dress code is mandatory. Only certain attire may be worn in and around the school, as well as on school-sponsored trips and at school events. By choosing **Kells**, parents and students agree to follow all dress code guidelines. Students who choose not to follow the dress code incur dress code infractions and will be issued consequences. (see below)

The following items must have the **Kells** logo or insignia: navy blazer, navy v-neck sweater, Oxford light blue shirt, black sweatpants, black gym shorts, royal blue t-shirts, light blue polos and **Kells** hoodie. These items must be purchased online at TOP MARKS: www.topmarks.ca Kells password: KEL01. Skirts are optional and must also be purchased at Top Marks. All non-Kells items may be purchased anywhere they are available, but they must be identical in style and colour to the stipulated dress code items.

Students are expected to come to school in a neat, clean, tailored, and pressed uniform. **Free Dress Day** guidelines will be explained at school.

Internal policies on presentation of the Dress Code

- All shirts must be pressed and fully tucked in.
- Pants and skirts must be pressed and clean. No tears or alterations.
- Only white T-shirts can be worn under the shirt and should have no visible logos.
- Ties must be worn at or near the collar.
- Hair color and styles as well as makeup and jewelry must be conservative in nature.
- Tights and knee highs must not have tears or holes.
- No hats, headphones, or ear buds are allowed unless approved by a staff member

Consequences for non adherence to Dress Code Policy

- Dress Code violation = 30-minute detention immediately after school until 3:30 pm.
- Repeated dress code infractions will result in the student being sent home
